## **Breakdown of Project Cost**

- High School Renovations: \$8,217,430.00
- Intermediate School Renovations: \$19,878,534.00
- North Hornell Renovations: \$2,039,586.00
- Capitalized Interest & DASNY Fees: \$1,904,450.00
- TOTAL: \$32,040,000.00

Main office is dated not efficient and lacks function and visibility to entrance. Nurses office is dated and not designed for comfort and support of students.

#### **Proposed plan:**

Upgrade and improve function and layout of both the main office and nurses office. Both upgrades will create more welcoming atmosphere and will be designed to maximize efficiency and support students.








#### **Current situation:**

Roof is off warranty and failing. Canopy and entryway are dated and in need of repair.

#### **Proposed plan:**

Complete a full depth replacement of failing roof and replace entryway connected to the bus loop.

## **Hornell High School**

#### **Current situation:**

Seventh and eighth grade classrooms and corridors are dated. Two bathrooms are dated.

#### **Proposed plan:**

Upgrade seventh and eighth grade classrooms and corridors to match the remainder of the building. Improve security and instructional technology.







#### **Current situation:**

Turf is failing and in regular need of repair and the tennis courts have been unsuitable for playing for several years.

#### **Proposed plan:**

Replace current turf and rebuild tennis courts for student and community use.










#### Phase 2 Potential Scope

### On the ballot

Shall the bond resolution, dated October 26, 2022, of the City School District of the City of Hornell, New York, set forth in the legal notice of this special referendum, authorizing addition to, construction, reconstruction and equipping of existing school buildings and facilities, site and incidental improvements, all at a maximum estimated aggregate cost of \$32,040,000, with the expenditure of \$4,150,000 from the existing capital reserve fund for such costs, the levy of a tax in annual installments therefor, to be offset by State aid available therefor, the issuance of not to exceed \$27,890,000 of debt obligations of the School District therefor, and providing that, if this proposition is approved by at least a sixty percent vote, such obligations may be issued in excess of the constitutional debt limit of the School District pursuant to applicable law, all as more fully described in such notice be approved?
