PROPOSITION NO. 1 - 2026-27 Budget

Shall the resolution authorizing the \$49,897,993 general fund budget of the Hornell City School District for 2026-27 be approved in accordance with Section 2022 of Education Law and that the balance of said budget after applying public monies thereto, be raised by a tax upon the taxable property of said district?

PROPOSITION NO. 2 – Expenditure from Transportation Reserve

Shall the following resolution be adopted, to wit:

RESOLVED that the Board of Education of the City School District of the City of Hornell, New York is hereby authorized to expend up to \$600,000 from the existing 2017-2027 Transportation Reserve Fund (remaining balance) and from the existing 2024-2034 Transportation Reserve Fund for the acquisition of school buses and/or other student transportation vehicles to replace existing fleet vehicles, expenditure to be made no later than June 30, 2027?

PROPOSITION NO. 3 – Create Transportation Reserve

Resolved that the Board of Education of the City School District of the City of Hornell, New York is hereby authorized to establish a transportation reserve fund pursuant to Section 3651 of the education law (to be known as the “2026-2036 Transportation Reserve Fund”), with the purpose of such fund being to finance the purchase of school buses, student transportation vehicles and equipment, and costs incidental thereto, the ultimate amount of such fund to be \$1,000,000. plus, earnings thereon, the probable term of such fund to be ten (10) years, and the sources from which the funds shall be obtained for such reserve are (i) amounts from budgetary appropriations from time to time, and (ii) unappropriated fund balance made available by the board of education from time to time, and (iii) New York State aid received and made available by the board of education from time to time, all to the extent permitted by law?

PROPOSITION NO. 4- Public Library

Shall the annual sum of money to be raised by taxation from the residents of the Hornell City School District for the Hornell Public Library be increased from \$407,382 to \$454,734 in accordance with New York State Education Law, EDN §259, to provide public library services?

PROPOSITION NO. 5- Purchase of Maple City Park

Shall the Board of Education of the Hornell City School District be authorized to expend the sum of Fifty-Two Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-Four dollars (\$52,234.00) for the purchase of the following (collectively, the "Property"): (A) all of the fee simple interest in, to and under an approximately 12.032 acre portion of that certain parcel of real property located at Seneca Street – Adsit Maple City Park, City of Hornell, State of New York (bearing tax account number 151.10-02-010.100) (the "Land"); and (B) any improvements located on the Land, for use for one or more purposes permitted under New York Education Law Sections 416(1), 2511(1), which is estimated to be the total maximum cost thereof, and to pay for the Property by spending \$52,234 from the District's general fund?
